
I trained as a Celebrant and Camomile Ceremonies was born.



Some element egs

These are unexpectedly lovely moments for your guests to witness – remember, they will most likely be expecting just the usual vows, ring exchange and a kiss.

A Unity Sand Ceremony, Different coloured sand is blended, the sand-filled vase becomes a beautiful and meaningful keepsake. This ceremony is a visual symbolisation of the couple joining together and can be a perfect representation of two families coming together. Involving children, and parents or friends as the couple wish.

A Gin and Tonic Ceremony, It's a little added extra where favourite Gins and Tonics (other drinks possible) are blended and shared as a symbol of the couple coming together and the joy of the union.

A Blessing of the hands Ceremony, A hand joining ceremony with special words and ribbons. Other family members can be involved. The ribbons can be personalised to fit with the wedding theme or things that have a special meaning for the couple. The hand joining ribbons become a beautiful and meaningful keepsake.

A Lock and key Ceremony. The couple symbolically close a padlock together, joining their hearts forever. Much as a lock cannot be unlocked without the key neither can their love. The key is buried, tossed into the river or sea to show the love cannot be divided as the lock cannot be opened.

Many other ceremonies are possible, once a celebrant knows you better they can suggest others. All will be accompanied by a personalised script.

What Can you expect from a Celebrant

A celebrant is a person who performs ceremonies marking some of life's biggest milestones. As well as officiating weddings, celebrants often perform vow renewals, baby naming ceremonies and funerals. For weddings, a celebrant will create a bespoke, meaningful ceremony that isn't religious. The magic happens on the day but also in the preparation. You will have:

- A one-to-one consultation, usually in person (can be virtual as well) between 1-2 hours.
- A follow up email outlining all we have agreed.
- Questionnaires between now and your occasion for you to complete which make sure all the detail and special things are captured.
- Special ceremony elements, the number depends on the package you have selected. Choose a package to suit your budget and your needs.
- A researched and personalised ceremony which takes 6-8 hours minimum to create.
- A reading of the draft ceremony in advance, so you can check it has the right "feel" and make any changes
- Depending on package, a venue liaison visit 1 to 2 hours or a zoom a week before to do a run through rehearsal
- My full attention on the day, I only book one event to officiate a day.
